Live animals may be purchased and sent to a locker or may be bought and resold at a slaughterhouse. Slaughterhouse buyers will be attending.

Transportation to processing plants will be provided <u>only</u> for animals sold in the auction.

A floor price will be set according to the current market trends the day of the auction. A list of current market prices will be available.

Pork and lamb carcasses will be sold whole. Beef carcasses will be sold in halves.

Each year, some 4-H exhibitors choose to retain ownership of their show animals to show at other fairs throughout the summer. When this happens in 2023, buyers will only pay the difference between their bid and market price. To illustrate, if market price is \$.60 per pound and you bid \$.80 per pound, the difference would be \$.20 per pound. You would pay the sale clerk \$.20 per pound and leave the auction without further business to transact.
